He sang as a soloist and as part of several groups: Undivided Heart, The Master's Quartet, Potter's Clay, and Three In One. His love for God spills over into his truly anointed voice, and when he sings you not only hear the song but feel it as well. Doug enjoys singing lead, tenor, baritone, and his favorite part, bass. He also enjoys playing the piano in many of their arrangements. Doug has written one song, the title track of their album *You Are My Strength*. He enjoys family game nights and book read alouds. He also enjoys working in their family garden and looks forward to their harvest of fruits and vegetables each year.

Christina, a 2013 homeschool graduate, has followed God's call to continue with their ministry full time.
